Core Function

- Provide a comprehensive environmental health program to tribes and tribal organizations to effectively address environmental health and safety concerns affecting public health.

- All Tribes are sovereign and have their own enforcement component

Native Americans and Alaskan Natives are the only ethnic group born with the legal right to health care


Created as a result of treaties
